### Code of Conduct for Children and Parents

RCC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. Paul Blackwell is the Club Welfare Officer.

As a member of RCC you and your children are expected to abide by the junior code of conduct:

- Play within the rules of the game and respect officials and their decisions (this includes parents too!)
- Respect the dignity and rights of all participants, regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Keep to the agreed timings for training and competitions or inform the Head Coach if they are going to be late
- Wear suitable kit for training and match sessions. In matches involving a hard ball this includes helmets and protectors for batters and wicketkeepers when using a hard ball
- Fees must be paid promptly
- Members must treat all club facilities and property with care ensuring all areas are clean and tidy after use and equipment is properly stored
- Ensure your child has appropriate refreshment, suitable clothing and sunscreen where necessary
- Ensure the coaches are made aware of any medical ailments or allergies that may affect your child in your absence
